


# Official Pork Roll Palooza Quoit Team Tournament Rules



Teams will consist of two fully paid players. If registered by 10/1/18 the fee was \$20/team, if registered after the fee is \$30/team. All teams must be pre-paid. No Substitute players.

Brackets will be completed from a random drawing following the 2pm rules meeting.

Teams can bring their own quoits, but have to present a full set of 4 and all parties agree to use.

The quoit boards will be set up to be 18ft apart before games begin. Teammates will stand at opposite boards to throw towards each other. Players will stand diagonally across from each other.

Teams will flip a quoit to determine which team will begin the series. They will then rotate for next 2 games.

All matches are played as the best 2-out-of-3 games. All games in a match are to 21 points. Must win by 2.

Players will alternate pitching quoits after the first player throws. After the first set of throws to begin a game, the team that scores in the previous set of throws will begin pitching in the next set. Players may not step in front of the end of the board to throw. In this instance, a foul will be called and the quoit will not count.

Only 1 team in a set of throws may score. The quoit nearest the hob will count as 1 point and a ringer will count as 3 points. NO Leaners. A scoring quoit must be within the width of the diameter of the quoit from edge to hob to count as a point. Any quoit that hits the ground first will be "dead" and removed from the board. Also, any quoit landing on the board upside down will be "dead" and removed from the board.

If a team has 2 ringers together, it will count as 6 points. If a team gets a ringer, and then is topped by the other team, the team with the last ringer will get 3 points.

The first team to 21 points or more will win the game. Must win by 2. Therefore, if a game is 21-20, it will continue to be played until a 2-point lead exists.

If any teammate leaves the site during a game or exhibits unbecoming behavior, and automatic forfeit will result (without refund).

Sportsmanship to be determined at the discretion of the Palooza official on site. All players on all teams MUST adhere to good sportsmanship. There will be zero tolerance for any player/team not using good sportsmanship.

Any player ejected from the game/match, will be ineligible to play in 2019.

Champions will be announced with medals & prizes at 5:30pm on Porkinator Main Stage.
